

Port: Constanta, Romania

Location: Constanta is situated on the W coast of the Black Sea, approx 179nm from the Bosphorus and 85nm from the mouth of Sulina waterway through which the Danube flows into the sea, approx 250km E of Bucharest.

General overview: It is the principal port of Romania and the largest on the Black Sea. The general cargo consists of imports of industrial equipment, foods, fertilisers and chemical products, textiles, building products, clothes, electrical appliances and furniture. Exports consisting of furniture and wood products, steel products, fertilisers and chemical products, foods, textiles, glass products, cement and cars.

Traffic figures: Approx 61,303,770t of cargos, 670,000TEU's and 13,626 vessels handled annually.

Max size: LOA 300m, draught 17m, 220,000DWT.
