

Port: Jeddah, Saudi Arabia

Location: Jeddah, located on the Red Sea coast, is the principal port of Saudi Arabia.

General overview: The port handles 56% of the total annual national seaborne tonnage and 67% of all imported foodstuffs. Jeddah is a well-equipped port with numerous facilities including container terminals, Ro-Ro and Passenger terminals, desalination plant, bulk grain terminal, grain, flour and rice mills and separate livestock, frozen goods and offshore oil terminals. The sub port of Shoaiba, under the Port Authority of Jeddah, lies approx 75nm S of Jeddah and comprises three tanker jetties owned by the private power and desalination companies operating in the area.

Traffic figures: Approx 55,000,000t of cargo, 4,100,000TEU, 300,000 passengers and 4,000 vessels handled annually.

Max size: LOA 260m, draught 14m, 100,000 DWT
