

## Port: Vancouver, Canada

**Location:** Vancouver (Canada) (alternative name, Port Metro Vancouver) is in Canada's westernmost province and lies at the centre point of the North American W Coast.

**General overview:** Vancouver is the largest full service port in Canada, handling most types of cargo. The main facilities are sited on North and South shores of Burrard Inlet, and Burrard Inlet East of Second Narrows, a well protected and easily navigable waterway virtually in the heart of greater Vancouver. The port area also includes Terminals at Roberts Bank, 22km S of Burrard Inlet and reached by a 3.5km long road and railway, stretching out from the shoreline with two facilities; the Deltaport Container Terminal and Westshore Terminals' largest and most modern deep water coal handling facility in North America. Facilities in the Fraser River are also now included within the Port of Vancouver's limits. Fraser River is a major storage area for log rafts, which supply the raw materials for the area's lumber and plywood mills, and a transshipment area for dry bulk cargoes using barges.

**Traffic figures:** Approx 135,600,000t of cargo, 2,930,000TEUs, 3,100 vessels and 827,000 passengers handled annually.

**Max size:** Draught 13.6m.
