

## Port: Wilmington, USA

**Location:** Situated in Delaware, midway between New York City and Washington DC, Wilmington is the first inbound deep-water port on the Delaware River, 65 miles from the Atlantic Ocean.

**General overview:** The port, owned and operated by Diamond State Port Corporation, is North America's main gateway for imports of fresh fruit, juice concentrates and palletised frozen beef. It is the largest container terminal on the Delaware River and the world's primary banana hub, with large dockside cold storage facilities. The port handles containers, fruit, juice concentrates, frozen meat, newsprint, lumber, steel, vehicles, dry and liquid bulk.

**Traffic figures:** Approx 6,700,000t of cargo, 190,000TEU and 380 vessels handled annually.

**Max size:** LOA 218m, draught 11.9m.
