

Port: Chernomorsk, Ukraine

Location: The port of Chernomorsk is situated on the coast of Yarylgach Bay in the Black Sea on the NW part of the Crimean Peninsula. The location of the port in the deep-water estuary, connected to the sea by the entrance channel, creates natural protection of the water area from waves and streams, and also provides year-round navigation.

General overview: Chernomorsk is a modern mechanized transport hub, which specializes in handling general (container, metal) and liquid/bulk cargoes. It's one of the largest ports of Ukraine, located at the intersection of nine transport corridors, including TRACECA (Transport Corridor Europe-Caucasus-Asia) and GUAM (Organization for Democracy and Economic Development)

Traffic figures: Multimodal complex (Terminal No 5): 4.5 million tons of cargo in wagons, 150 thousand TIR vehicles and 250 thousand units of wheeled vehicles per year.

Max size: Draught 6.0 m. Multimodal complex (Terminal No 5): draught 9.0 m.
