

## Port: Houston, USA

**Location:** The port of Houston is 326nm NE of Brownsville in the SE of Texas.

**General overview:** The port of Houston is a 40km long complex of diversified public and private facilities. The Port of Houston Authority (PHA) operates the public facilities located along the Houston Ship Channel, including Buffalo Bayou, Sims Bayou, Hunting Bayou, Greens Bayou, Boggy Bayou Basin, Goose Creek, Cedar Bayou, Barbours Cut and Bayport. The port also operates and manages a foreign trade zone site. Import: Petroleum products, iron/steel, LPG, organic chemicals, and crude fertilisers. Export: Cereals/grains, petroleum products, organic chemicals, polymer plastics and inorganic chemicals.

**Traffic figures:** Approx 236,000,000t of cargo, 2,300,000TEU, 8,400 vessels and 26,300 passengers handled annually.

**Max size:** Draught 13.7m, LOA 336.67m, Beam 51.2m, 185,000DWT. Beam unrestricted at LBC Houston - Bayport Terminal Ship Dock's No. 1 and No. 2.
