

Port: Jebel Ali, UAE

Location: The port is located on the Gulf coast approx 35km SW of Dubai.

General overview: The largest man made harbour in the world, with a large industrial development including aluminium, gas and cement facilities. The merger and relocating with Port Rashid also brought a large increase in container handling. Facilities exist to accommodate Ro-Ro's, container ships, bulkers, general cargo vessels and tankers.

Traffic figures: Approx 37,000,000t of cargo, 15,000,000TEUs and 18,000 passengers handled annually.

Max size: LOA 400m, draught 15.5m, 125,000DWT
